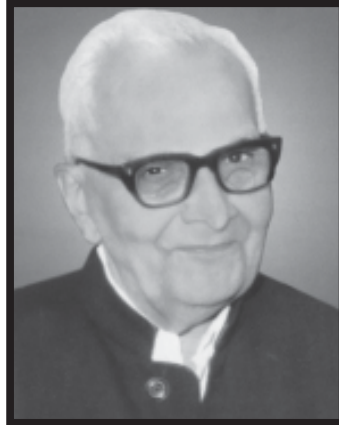

Institution has constructed the buildings step by step in the span of 54 years. Now they require repairs and renovation. Govt. does not give grant for it. I therefore appeal to the donors on behalf of the institution to donate for repairs and renovation of the buildings As you know that in last one year prices of cereals , milk and vegetables, has gone higher by 50 to 60%. There is no increase in the grant to match this cost inflation. We request our donors to contribute in kind like wheat, rice, cereals and pulses, spices, vegetables, milk, tea, sugar etc. This will be a great relief to us.

I am externally thankful to the trustees, members of the managing committee, sectionl heads, all members of the staff and honorary workers for the co-operation given to me. I am happy to inform our members and donors that looking to excellent work done by our institution Govt. of Gujarat has given us an Award in recognition of our Contribution in this field. Mandal runs in-door and out-door physiotherapy centres, equipped with modern instruments. We arranged medical check-up camps in rural areas of the state and distributed equipment aids free of charge.

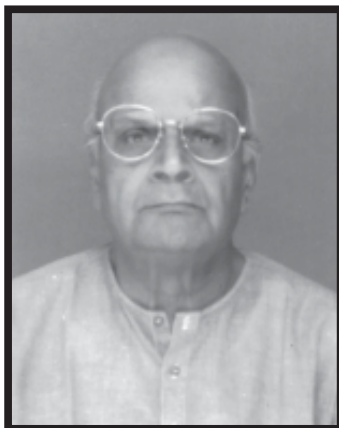

Kalyanbhai is associated with our institution since last 54 years and he continuously provides inspiration and guidance. His main contribution to our mandal is rehabilitation programme for physically disabled. He takes active interest in compiling data and research activities for eradication of disability of various types from the society especially Polio. At this age he visits our relief camps and provides support to our doctors and staff.



## **:: State Government Award ::**

Institutional Second Award for the year 2007 was delivered to Apang Manav Mandal for meritorious welfare activities for Handicapped by Hon. Shri Fakirbhai Vaghela, Hon. Minister for Social Justice & Empowerment, Gujarat State, Gandhinagar on 24th June, 2012. Vice President Shri K.H. Kaji was honoured on behalf of A.M.M. with a merit certificate, shawl and a cheque of Rs. 45,000/-. President Shri Anilbhai Parikh and a member of Managing Committee Shri Bankimbhai Pathak were present at the event.

## **ACTIVITIES AT A GLANCE**

Looking to the demands of the students, parents and workers for Higher Secondary Std. XI was started in the school. Students were taught in Std. I to XI, Various competitions, picnics, tours and cultural and development activities were carried out during the year. Books, note books, full scape note books, school bags, uniform and school bus facilities were provided to the students free of charge. In order to encourage them, prizes were given who stood 1st, 2nd and 3rd rank in annual examination in each standard. Lift was installed in school buildnig which is a great help to the disabled students.

### **[1] Education :**

#### **1:1 Shri K. K. Shah Jarodwala Primary School**

##### **Prof. Hiralal Kaji Primary School :-**

Primary education is very important for future development. Model room with all amenities for class I to IV was prepared. The room is centrally air conditioned. Education was given on Audio Visual system in std. V to VII.

#### **1:2 Suman Udyan :-**

In order to provide education beyond class room with Joy and fun to children of class I to IV an educational dome was constructed. It is sourended with pictures, sketches, different shapes, colours and garden which provide encouragment for learning to the special students. Vice President Shri K. H. Kaji assisted for such novel project.

#### **1:3 Shri Sunandaben Vohora Secondary School :-**

It was planned to give quality education to the students studying in std. VIII to XI. Result of S.S.C. Board's examination was 92%. Prizes were given to the students who got good marks in each standard. There are two computer laboratories with latest equipments. Higher Secondary Std. XI was started in the year and Std. XII will be started in due course.

**1:4 School Bus :-**

Institution introduced for the first time School Bus facilities for the disabled students staying in Ranip, Vadaj, Shahpur, Vejalpur and some remote areas of the city. This facility is provided free of charge. Moreover students are given lunch / snacks in the institution. We got four school bus including two mini bus in donation. We received two mini Vans as donation especially for this outreach project. One vane by Smt. Sulochanaben Dalal with courtesies of Dhirenbbhai Jhavari and the second one was donated by Smt. Indiraben and Shri Arvindbhai Shah Public Charitable Trust with Courtesies of Shri K.H. Kaji. 45 disabled students are availing this facilities.

**1:5 National Paraolympics Wheel Chair Tennis Competition :-**

Eight disabled boys and girls took part in National Paraolympics Wheel Chair Tennis Competition held during 10-12-2011 to 14-12-2011 at Banglore. Manisha V. Rathod got first prize of Rs. 50,000/- and Raiya Shathiya got second prize of Rs. 49,000/- All other six participants each got cash prize of Rs. 5,000/-

**1:6 Shri Madanmohan Ramanlal Spastic Learning and Day-care Centre :-**

The main object of this centre is to provide children with mental and physial disorder better life and basic and primary education and training. Special educators and experts provide them speech therapy. Various activities like picnics, sports competition and celebration of fastivals are arranged. Parents of these children are also involved in their activities and celebrations.

**1:7 Shri Ramniklal Jivanlal Computer Education Centre :-**

190 students were taught computer as one of the subject in Std. V to XI by qulified and well trained instructors. 100% result was achieved in the S.S.C. Board's examination.

Moreover professional courses were carried out after school hours charging nominal fees. 75% relief in course fee was granted to the disabled who attend as external students. Merit certificate was given on completion of course.

**1:8 Assistance for Education and Scholarship for Higher Studies :-**

Various schemes were implemented to encourage for education so that disabled students may brighten their future carrier by acquiring higher education. Cash prizes were awarded to the brilliant students. Free lodging and boarding were provided who had continued higher studies in Ploytechnic, Technical Courses, College etc. This is to inspire them to become self reliant in life.

**[2] Vocational Training :-**

Training was imparted in different vocations to disabled boys and girls. Free lodging and boarding were provided to them. Stipend was also paid to them. They were made capable to earn their livelihood after the training.

**2:1 Sheth Shri Purshotamdas Mulchand Printing Training Centre :-**

Training in D.T.P., Computer, Offset, Screen Printing was imparted to the disabled in the centre. Lodging and boarding facilities were given to them. Stipend was given to the inmates as well as to day boarders.

**2:2 Shri Bhagwatiben Vishnukumar Pandya (Sahitya Mundranalaya) Graphic Art Training Centre :-**

Professional training was imparted in D.T.P., Computer, offset, Screen Printing, Book-binding on advanced machines in the Centre. This centre's specialison in good printing work and on-time deliveries to various clients such as, Cadila Pharmaceuticals, Gujarat Cancer Society, Gujarat Cancer and Resarch Institute, Ellisbridge Arogya Samiti, Late Thakorbbhai Desai Samark Trust, D.C. Engineering Industries, Indian Overseas Bank etc. We got good response from companies, banks and other establishments. We are grateful to all for their co-opration in providing printing work to us, which is done by our disable children.

**2:3 Shri Kalindi Kaji Fashion and Apparel Design Training Centre :-**

Disabled girls were imparted training in designing, cutting, stitching and finishing work for modern apparel / dresses in the centre. They become skilled artisan after the completion of training and easily get job. Some of them do their own business in sewing work and earn their living.



Institution has registered its trade mark as **पुर्नदा**<sup>®</sup>. We have good orders from 'Fab India', 'Moral Fiber' and other companies. Exhibition-cum-sale was arranged at 'Beyond Gallery' of Paravben who is daughter of Shri Vipinbhai Shantilal Parikh a wellknown lawyer of Ahmedabad. We got response and our efforts were praised and encouraged by the society at large.

#### **2:4 Shri Madanmohan Ramanlal Fashion and Apparel Design Training Centre :-**

We have started this centre to train disabled as skilled artisans. After getting one year training in our sewing section disabled youths were admitted in the centre. Centre is well equipped with modern machines in stitching & and knitting. We accept orders form the companies and others. Trainees were given free lodging, boarding and stipends.

#### **2:5 Sheth Shri Ramanlal Girdharlal Sewing Training Centre :-**

##### **Boys Training Centre renovated by Shri Vidyaben Bhalubhai Desai Charitable Trust :-**

We run sewing training course for boys and girls which is recognised by State Technical Board. Out of 21 trainees who appeared in the examination, 20 candidates secured I<sup>st</sup> class and 1 candidate passed in II<sup>nd</sup> class. Trainees were given stipend and free lodging & boarding facilities. Sewing kit was given to one boy trainee and one girl trainee who stood in first rank in board examination.

#### **[3] Hostel Section :-**

##### **3:1 Shri Prabodhbhai Popatlal Ravchand Boys Hostel Section - I :-**

##### **Shri Bhogilal Balabhai Boys Hostel Section - I :-**

Nutritious and good quality food, soap, hair-oil, beddings, sweater, two pairs of uniform and medical facilities were provided to 175 disabled boys in the hostel. National & religious festivals were celebrated in the hostel. Importance is given for discipline and cultural values in day to day living.

**3:2 Smt. Vasantben Hiralal Kaji Girls Hostel :-**

Separate hostel for disabled girls is situated at Memnagar near Gandhi Labour Institute. 150 girls were admitted in the hostel. All facilities like boys hostel were provided to girls also. Moreover school bus facility was provided free of charge. Lift is installed and it will be in operation very soon.

**[4] Treatment & Equipment Aids :-**

Disabled students from rural areas are admitted in the institution. Medical check-up camps were organised for them. They were given medicines, physiotherapy treatment and equipment aids as per doctors advice.

**4:1 Shri Manilal Jethalal Shah Indoor Physiotherapy Centre (Drive-in-road) :-**

Disabled boys and girls were examined by Hon. Ortho. Surgeon Dr. Mehulbhai Shah and Physiotherapist Dr. Manishbhai Trivedi in the initial stage. Physiotherapy treatment and operation were carried out as per their advice to the needy. It has helped in reducing their disability to some extent.

**4:2 Nutan Nagrik Sahakari Bank Ltd. Cultural activity Centre (Drive-in-road) :-****Shri Daulatbhai and Nanubhai Trivedi Health Centre :-****Shri Chimanbhai Somabhai Patel (Sandesh) Paediatric****Physiotherapy Centre**

Centre is well equipped including Lessertherapy and Combothrapy Unit. Physiotherapy treatment was given to the patients as per their requirement. This centre is centrally airconditionad. 30193 patients were given treatment at nominal charges during the year.

**4:3 Shri Shantaben Motilal Parikh Physiotherapy Centre :- (Vastrapur-road)**

Indoor and outdoor patients were treated by qualified physiotherapist in the centre. Modern equipments for physiotherapy and health are installed in the centre. This centre is open for 12 hours. i.e. 8 A.M. to 8 P.M. which is centrally air conditioned. 33005 patients were treated in the centre during the year. Special health programs are designed by qualified doctor to meet individual need.

**4:4 Medical Check up and Equipment Aids :-**

Medical check up programme was arranged in association with “Satya Sai Seva Sangathan” for disabled boys and girls. Voluntary services were given by Dr. Rameshbhai, Dr. Vinodbhai and 28 social workers. Blood tests of students were done by Dr. Rajnibhai Patel, Eye check up for 21 students were done by Dr. Sanjaybhai Gandhi. Dr. Mehulbhai Shah, Ortho. Surgeon diagnosed the students and advised to 54 beneficiaries for artificial limbs, crutches, walker, ground level device etc. Dr. Narhari Prasad Mehta diagnosed the students who had pain in hands and legs. All these services were extended voluntarily to disabled students.

Assistance for operation and equipment aids distributed to our students in the year 2011-2012.

### **4:5 Free Diagnostic, Treatment and Equipment Aids Camp :-**

Research and Survey was carried out to extend benefit for education, training and other assistance to physically challenged staying in rural areas.

Free Diagnostic Camps were organised for orthopedic patients and equipment aids were distributed to them at D.C. Mehta Sarvajanik Dispensary Trust, Morbi, Rotari Club of Anjar, Anjar and Lions Club of Anand, Anand during the year.

### **4:6 Treatment and Vaccination :-**

#### **(i) Ailment :-**

Disabled boys and girls staying in our hostel some time fall ill, suffering from minor fever, common cold, throat, skin diseases, girls having gynaecological problems etc. In order to provide immediate treatment and relief Dr. Mrugeshbhai Shah had offered services at boys hostel and Dr. Urvashiben Sutaria at girls hostel regularly twice a week.

Shri Kanishkbhai Kaji, Shri Navnitbhai Choksi and Shri Thakorbbhai Amin Trustees of Shri Daulatbhai Nanubhai Trivedi Trust had donated Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh) to meet the expenses for the treatment.

**(ii) Vaccination :-**

Apang Manav Mandal has created “Justice B.J. Diwan Immunization Fund” and allotted Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh) in memory of President Trustee & President Emeritus of Apang Manav Mandal Late Justice B. J. Diwan. Disabled boys and girls will be treated as per their need every year from interest amount of the fund.

**(iii) Prosthetic Rehabilitation :-**

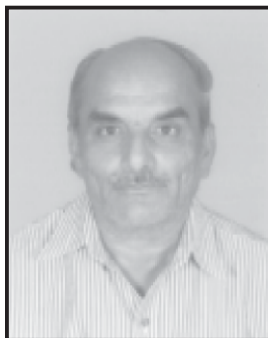
Govind Parmar a student of Apang Manav Mandal age 17, studying in std. XII, was suffering with Amputation below knee and could not walk independently. He was dependent on others for his activities.

Here he was fitted a left Modular Trans tibial prosthesis by “OTTOBOCK”. Now he is fully independent in walking and standing and doing all his normal activity of daily life easily. This prosthesis costed Rs. 33,500/- This facility is provided by Courtesies of Shri Prashant Kinarivala
